

STANDING ORDER

The Judicial Conference of the United States has set forth policies for the management and expenditure of attorney admission funds maintained locally by the courts of the United States. These are considered non-appropriated funds held in trust by the courts, and must be maintained separately from all other funds.

The United States District Court for the Western District of New York will hereby establish and maintain a "District Court Fund" for the purposes of collecting local attorney admission and pro hac vice fees. A *Plan for the Administration of the District Court Fund*, as well as its associated *Guidelines Governing Reimbursement*, will be filed with the Clerk's Office.
