Whereas Rule 6(e)(3)(B) of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure requires that a government attorney promptly provide to the impanelling judge the names of government personnel to whom disclosure of grand jury information has been made, together with such attorney's certification that said personnel have been advised of their obligation of secrecy, and

Whereas the providing of such names and certifications is an important part of safeguarding the grand jury process and the rights of persons affected by that process, it is now

Ordered, that the government shall file Rule 6(e)(3)(B) statements and certifications with the Clerk of this Court, who shall duly time-stamp them and retain them under seal for such review by the Court as may be necessary.
