ORDERED that in all civil actions filed in this Court, service shall be made other than by the United States Marshal Service, except in the following circumstances:

- Service of process on behalf of the United States;
- Service of process on behalf of litigants proceeding pro se who are authorized to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915;
- Service of process on behalf of litigants authorized to proceed as seamen under 28 U.S.C. § 1916;
- Service of writs of seizure, attachment, forfeiture, or execution; or
- Service of process pursuant to a specific order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that proof of service shall be filed promptly with the Clerk of Court.
