IN THE MATTER OF RULES OF COURT RELATIVE TO FORFEITURE OF COLLATERAL IN LIEU OF APPEARANCE IN SUITABLE TYPES OF MISDEMEANOR CASES

Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 4(a) of the Rules of Procedure for the Trial of Misdemeanors before United States Magistrate Judges,

IT IS ORDERED that the following rules relative to the forfeitures of collateral in lieu of appearance in suitable types of misdemeanor cases as set forth herein be and hereby are adopted as a Rule of the District Court of the United States for the Western District of New York.

1. For misdemeanors listed herein, whether originating under the applicable Federal statute or regulations or under applicable State statute by virtue of the Assimilative Crimes Act, 18 U.S.C. § 13, occurring within the territorial jurisdiction of the United States Magistrate Judges including areas within the boundaries of the United States military installations, public buildings and grounds and national forests, and property under the charge and control of the Veterans Administration or of the Postal Service, the person so charged may, in lieu of appearance, post collateral in the amount indicated for the offense, waive appearance before a United States Magistrate Judge, and consent to the forfeiture of collateral. If collateral is forfeited, such action shall be tantamount to a finding of guilty, but shall not be deemed a conviction.

- Those offenses marked with an asterisk (\*) and for which no amount of collateral is shown require a mandatory appearance before a United States Magistrate Judge.
- 3. If a person charged with an offense under Paragraph 1 of this Rule fails to post and forfeit collateral, any punishment, including fine, imprisonment or probation may be imposed within the limits established by law upon conviction or after trial.
- 4. Nothing contained in this Rule shall prohibit a law enforcement officer from arresting a person for the commission of any offense, including those for which collateral may be posted and forfeited, in which event the arrested person shall without unnecessary delay be taken before the nearest available Federal Magistrate Judge or in the event that a Federal Magistrate Judge is not reasonably available, before a State or local judicial officer authorized by 18 U.S.C. § 3041, as all provided in Rule 5 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.
