ADMINISTRATIVE  
ORDER

Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 1871(b)(2) if a petit juror is required to attend more than ten (10) days in hearing one case, such a juror may be paid an additional daily fee not exceeding \$10 more than the attendance fee. However, the presiding judge may determine, in his or her discretion, that such enhanced fees are not appropriate and may direct that they not be paid.

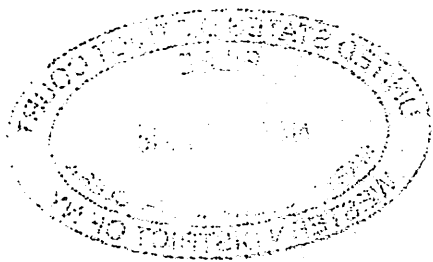
Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 1871(b)(3), a grand juror may be paid an additional fee not exceeding \$10 more than the attendance fee for each day in excess of forty-five (45) days of actual service.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall certify that every petit juror attending more than ten (10) days in the trial of an action, and every grand juror attending more than forty-five (45) days of grand jury proceedings, shall receive a supplemental daily fee of \$10, in addition to the daily attendance fee paid pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1871(b)(1). However, the presiding judge in his or her discretion may order that the supplemental fee be less than an additional \$10, or that it not be paid.

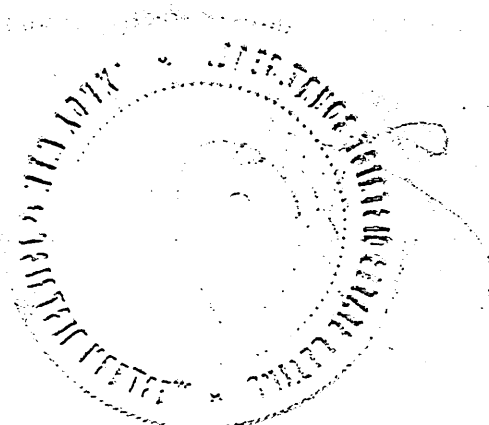
