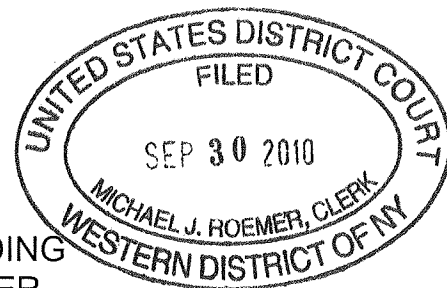


STANDING
ORDER

It appears to the Court that, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1868, the Clerk of Court must preserve all “records and papers” pertaining to a Master Jury Wheel for at least four (4) years. The four-year period begins after a court has emptied and refilled its Master Jury Wheel and all persons selected as jurors from that wheel have completed their service.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective immediately and until further notice, the Clerk of Court, or any Deputy Clerk under the supervision of the Clerk of Court, is authorized in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1868, to dispose of all “records and papers” pertaining to a Master Jury Wheel four years after the refilling of the Master Jury Wheel and after all persons selected as jurors from that wheel have completed their jury service in the Western District of New York.
