

STANDING ORDER


The Reentry Court Program in the Western District of New York targets high risk individuals through a comprehensive and coordinated network of services and enhanced accountability. The goal of the program is to maintain public safety by reducing recidivism and promoting successful community reintegration. Participants in the program are screened for eligibility and agree to be represented by the Federal Public Defender's Office. Participation is entirely voluntary.

To ensure the effective representation of the participant and to facilitate the efficient operation of the program, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the United States Probation Office for the Western District of New York is authorized to provide to the Federal Public Defender's Office for the Western District of New York copies of the Presentence Report and Judgment of Conviction with Statement of Reasons for any defendant who is accepted into the Reentry Court Program, without seeking leave from the individual sentencing judge.
